### Missoula Elections Office Relocating to Fairgrounds for Special Elections

Missoula County election services will be moved to the Elections Center at the Missoula County Fairgrounds for the two upcoming special elections. Providing services such as late registration and the issuance of ballots at the Elections Center ensures better access for voters. The Elections Center is able to accommodate more staff, which translates to reduced wait time for voters. This location also provides more parking, a ballot drop-off location, and additional voting equipment. In anticipation of the upcoming annual School Special District Election and the Special Federal Election, all election services will be held at the Fairgrounds between April 5 and May 31, 2017. The public will have the opportunity to:

- Register to vote;
- Receive a ballot;
- Drop off their ballot;
- File for the municipal election, which opens April 20, 2017;
- Park easily;
- Receive friendly and speedy service.

The annual School Special District Election will be held on Tuesday, May 2, 2017. Late registration opens on April 4. Members of the public may register to vote prior to this election, but must do so in-person at the Elections Office. The Elections Office will mail ballots on April 17. All ballots are due by 8 p.m. on Election Day, May 2.

The Special Federal Election to fill former Representative Ryan Zinke's seat will be held on Thursday, May 25, 2017. Late registration opens on April 26 and ballots are anticipated to mail on May 1. Ballots are due by 8 p.m. on Election Day, May 25.

For any voting services, the public should appear at the Fairgrounds Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.
