Western Montana Fair Friday Update

Friday is Bike to the Fair Day with valet bike parking for those who sustainably commute to the grounds. Bikers will receive vouchers to spend on food concessions while visiting the Fair.

Tonight brings Tough Enough to Wear Pink at the Rodeo to benefit breast cancer awareness. The Missoula Stampede PRCA Ram Rodeo will be on the arena tonight at 7 p.m. The public can continue to purchase tickets online or in the Fair Office.

From a rough count, at least 16,000 attendees walked through the gates yesterday and more than 1,400 attended last night's Missoula Stampede PRCA Ram Rodeo.

Taking the West Lawn stage today are the Canine Stars; Diving Dogs and Aerial Acrobats. There are free events for all visitors.

Other free daily events include the Keith Raymond Magic Show at 1 and 3 p.m.; music from Miller Campbell at 4 p.m. and Shodown at 5:30 and 9 p.m.; aerial acrobats will be performing on the West Lawn at 2:30 and 6:30 p.m.; and 4-H activities continue with hog, beef and sheep showmanship throughout the day and a pack goat obstacle course at 11 a.m.

The grounds open at 11 a.m. with the first carnival rides beginning at 12 p.m. All-day carnival tickets are still available for purchase at the Fairgrounds for \$35.
