Municipal General Election Ballots Mailing Wednesday

Forty-five thousand Municipal General Election ballots will be mailed to voters on Wednesday, Oct. 18. Ballots will be sent to those who are registered to vote within the municipal boundaries and have an "active" status with the elections office. Voters can check their voting status at www.MyVoterPageMT.com or by calling Missoula Votes at 258-4751 to confirm their information on file.

The municipal ballot includes the mayoral race, municipal judge, and ward councilmembers.

The Elections Center located at the Fairgrounds is now open to serve all election needs. Starting October 11, registering to vote or updating voter information must be done inperson at the Fairgrounds.

The following services are available:

- Register to vote;
- Change registration address;
- Receive a ballot;
- Drop off their ballot;
- Park easily;
- Receive friendly and speedy service;
- Vote using an ADA accessible AutoMark voting machine.

All ballots are due by 8 p.m. on Election Day, Nov. 7. For any voting services, the public should appear at the Elections Center located at the Fairgrounds Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.
